Contributions to Committee to Elect Rabbi Shifren are not tax deductible for Federal or California tax purposes. California law requires political committees to report the name, mailing address, occupation, and employer for each donor whose contributions aggregate \$100 or more per calendar year. Individual and corporate contributions are legally permitted in California state elections. Contributions may be made in any amount up to \$3,900 per election (primary and general) per individual or corporation. A husband and wife may make a contribution from a joint checking account in an amount of up to \$7,800 per election if both spouses sign the check or if each sends a separate check. Contributors of \$10,000 or more to Committee to Elect Rabbi Shifren and all other state or local candidates, PACs, political party committees, or ballot measures in a calendar year must file a California "Major Donor Committee" report.
